The 23rd International Symposium on Space Technology and Science (ISTS) was held at Shimane Prefectural Assembly Hall and Kunibiki Messe in Matsue City, Shimane

More than 10,000 people, including primary to university students, were visited. Many student could experienced the actual space development through the exhibition. 

presented from Japan and 8 papers
